What is the Purpose of the Grant Catalogue?

The purpose of the SSCF Grant Catalogue is to communicate capital campaigns, special projects and emergent needs of eligible organizations within the South Saskatchewan Community. While SSCF already acts as a bridge between donors and community needs, the grant catalogue will help us do so in a timely, transparent, and consistent manner.

The Four Unique SSCF Grant Catalogues

Emergent Need

A way to support unexpected and/or urgent need in your community.

Special Projects

A way to support vital projects and programs still seeking funding in order to be delivered in your community.

Capital Campaigns

A way to support typically larger-scale targeted fundraising efforts for more costly projects (such as a new building) that usually take place over a defined period of time. The Capital Campaign's size, scope and defined timelines require community support from multiple sources.

South Saskatchewan Vital Community Fund

(Formerly the Smart & Caring Fund)

A way to seek and support eligible and positively assessed projects that were not supported due to over-demand to the Vital Community Fund.

SSCF staff ensures that the charities and activities are eligible and each organization uploads a description of its need in a standardized format for your consideration.

When Can I Donate to the Grant Catalogue?

The Emergent Need, Special Projects and Capital Campaigns Grant Catalogues are ongoing and visible from January 1st until December 1st of each year. These three catalogues are updated monthly.

The South Saskatchewan Vital Community Fund Grant Catalogue is available for a limited two week time period following the grant program deadline of May 15th (the actual dates will be emailed in advance to Fund Advisors).
